AGREEMENT of electronic publishing and dissemination on the internet

On the one hand, the student, and on the other hand vice-rectorship of research in the name and on behalf of the University of Valladolid. Both parties mutually recognize the legal competence for hiring and for compelling in the quality in which they act for that purpose, and they MANIFEST:

FIRST: That the Student is the only author and the exclusive copyright holder of the Final Thesis.

SECOND: That the fundamental objective of this agreement is the implementation of an Institutional Open Archive whose purpose is the disclosure of the Final Theses submitted at the University of Valladolid. To conduct this implementation, the University gives the necessary technical means offering a full text data base in electronic format, through the Internet, facilitating this way the visibility and access to the scientific and technical information.

THIRD: That taking into account the previously stated, both parties are interested in establishing an Agreement that regulates the cession on part of the Author to the University of Valladolid of the reproduction and public communication rights in electronic format of the Final Thesis mentioned before, exclusively for the utilization specified in this Agreement.

For that purpose

THEY AGREE THAT:

1.--- The Author executes a non-exclusive cession of the work mentioned above to the University of Valladolid, with free nature and with the exclusive aims of investigation and teaching, as well as the reproduction and distribution rights in electronic format for its public dissemination.

2.--- The Library of the University of Valladolid by virtue of this Agreement, acquires the obligation of incorporating the Final Thesis into the institutional repository of the University of Valladolid. Without prejudice that in the future, with the aim of achieving a greater dissemination, it may be included in other repositories that can be established on a regional, national or international level.

3.--- The University of Valladolid will make available for its users this Final Thesis for private use and for the aims of investigation and teaching, although it does not guarantee nor take responsibility of the way the users will subsequently utilize of it.

4.--- In order to make effective the transfer of the rights mentioned in Clause 1, the Author will hand in the Final Thesis in full text as well as in PDF format to the Library of the University of Valladolid.

5.--- Both parties acknowledge and agree that the University has not got any intention of censuring nor revising the Theses, and consequently, the Author will be full responsible of the content of the aforementioned assignment.

6.--- The Author takes responsibility of the authorship and originality of the work before the University of Valladolid, stating that they have not contracted nor will contract commitments or obligations of any kind that will infringe upon the rights that belong to the University of Valladolid.

7.--- The ownership of the exploitation rights of the intellectual property on the Final Thesis belong and will continue to belong to the Author. The University acquires the rights that appear specifically in this Agreement and particularly the ones that are specified in Clause 1. Likewise, it will be denoted in the institutional archive of the University express reference to the authorized uses of the work, under the license of Creative Commons. All of the Works incorporated in the University's Repository, will have by default with the license of: Recognition of the Work – Non-commercialization – Without derivative work. Unless the autor specifically informs of another modality of license Creative Commons.

8.--- This Agreement will come into effect the day it will be signed and it will have an indefinite duration. Without prejudice of the initially agreed indefinite duration, this Agreement will be able to terminate: due to the willingness of the parties, due to the non-compliance of any of the obligations under the Agreement.

CONFIDENTIALITY AGREEMENT

The work will not be added to the Document Repository of the University of Valladolid (nor will be the descriptive metadata of the work). The library will guard the digital support of the confidential work during the time allotted by the Regulation of the Academic Planning. After this period, the confidential work will be sent to the corresponding Administrative Archive.

The Library will be able to hand over copies of the confidential work as required by the Office of Studies and Evaluation in order to fulfill with the renovation of the certification of the official titles of Degree, according to the established procedure in the Royal Decree 1393/2007, by which the ordinance of the official teaching is regulated, edited by the RD 861/2010.
